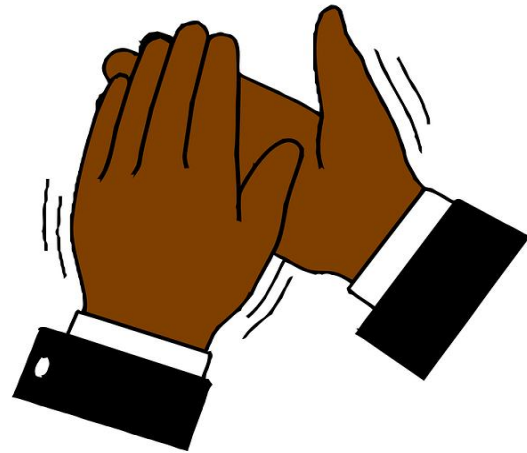
The purpose of the Men's Club of FSSK is to promote understanding and practice social interaction between men residing in the FSSK community.
